- ❖ After France I would like to teach and then receive my doctorate of education



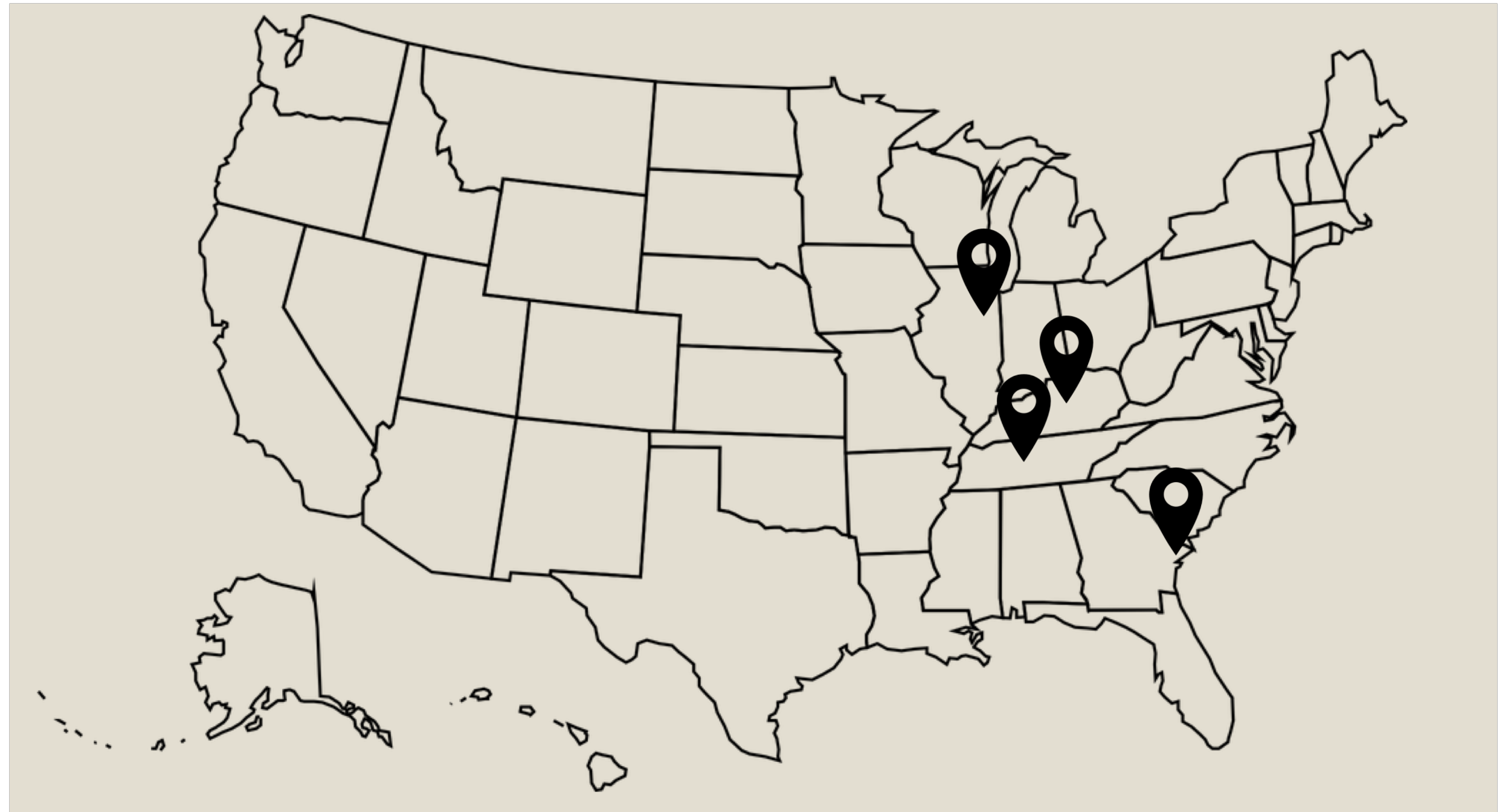


Chicago, Illinois

- ❖ To teach in France I had to travel to Chicago this summer to receive my visa



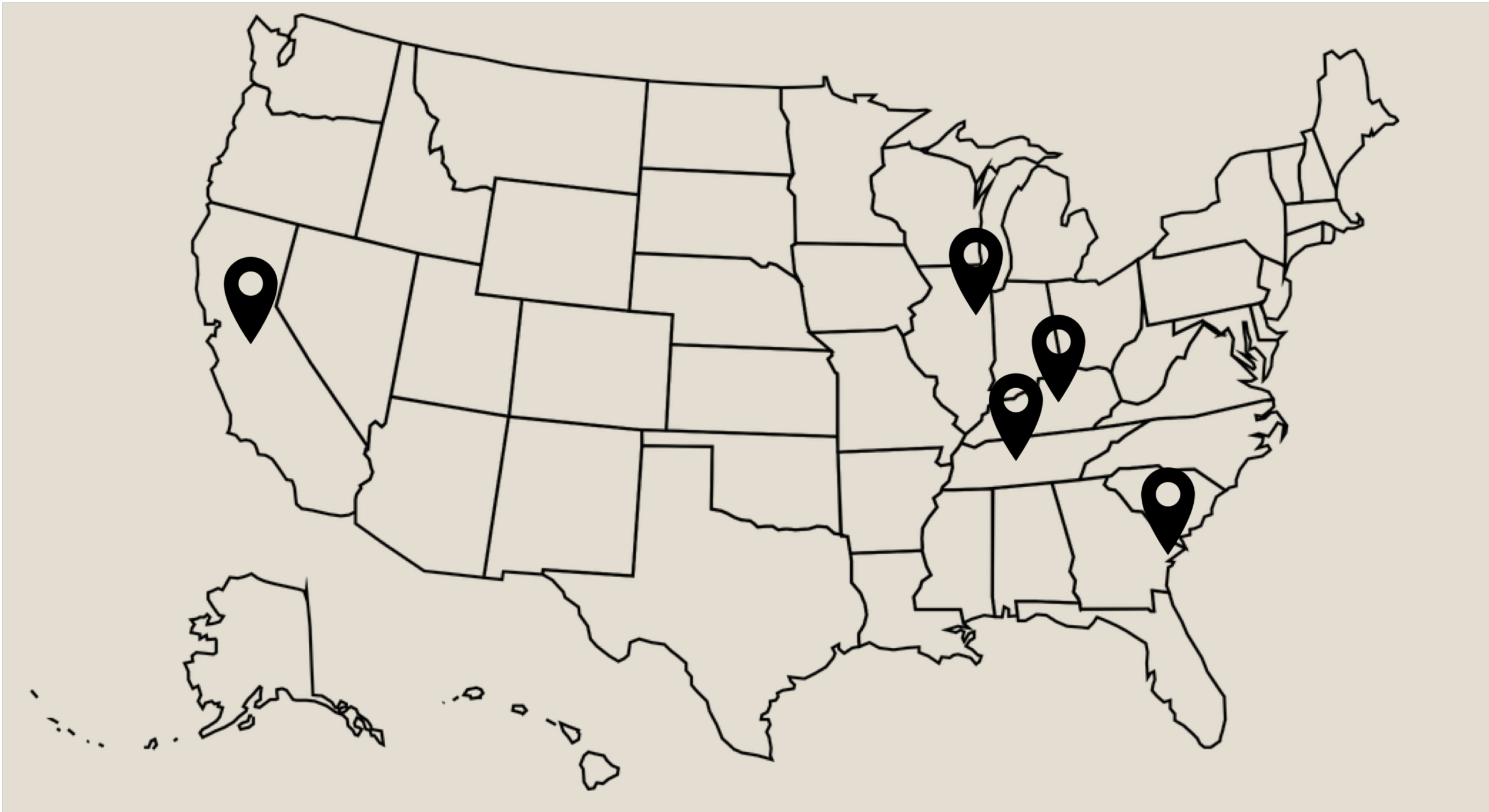


Savannah, Georgia

Yosemite, California

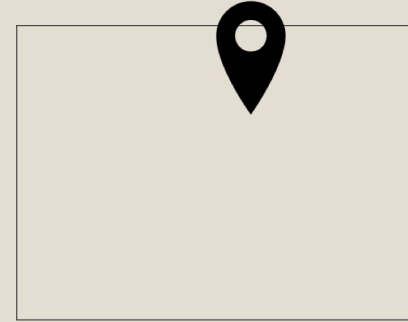


- ❖ I have lots of family in California
